5 SHOOTING BOX TOWER, NETHERFIELD, EAST SUSSEX

Surrounded by beautiful lush woodland, this former shooting lodge has been converted into a gorgeous country retreat. It has every mod con while retaining a historic feel. The light, elegant lounge – with high ceilings, polished floorboards and huge Gothic revival windows – feels grand without being ostentatious, while the four bedrooms each have

6 BRIDGE HOUSE, THORNOLG, NORFOLK

Cottages don't come more perfect than the thatched 17th century Bridge House, which has climbing plants growing up the flint walls and roses in the garden. Inside, the low-beamed lounge feels wonderfully cosy, with a luxurious Chesterfield sofa to sink into, and the second sitting room has a wood burner in the feature fireplace to create a really rustic-chic feel. The three bedrooms on the second

floor are interlinked, making it more suitable for a family than a group of friends. Sleeps eight.

7 THE SNUG, HAWES, WENSLEYDALE

Fans of vintage interiors will fall in love with this picture-perfect bolthole in the heart of a pretty market town. The stone-flagged floors in the lounge are warmed by an open fire while the neat kitchen has a small eating area with a cute window seat. Upstairs are two bedrooms but this is the perfect house for a romantic escape for two, with fluffy duvets and lovely vintage-style furniture. The town's pubs, restaurants and shops are a short stroll away. Sleeps four.

Craster Reach combines a cosy feel with luxury at every turn. From the outside the cottage looks unremarkable, but inside it's clear how much work has gone into converting it into a luxury bolthole. The three bedrooms are crisply decorated in muted shades of stone and cream with seascapes on the walls. Downstairs, the gleaming kitchen looks like something out of an interiors magazine and the separate lounge and dining areas mean there's a real feeling of space. Decked seating areas at the front and back make the most of the wonderful sea air. Sleeps six.
